The 20th of May is celebrated as World Metrology Day, commemorating the anniversary of the signing of the Meter Convention in 1875. This constitutes the basis of a measurement system consistent worldwide.

The theme for 2013 is "**Measurements in everyday life.**" In the course of a normal day, it is amazing the amount of measurements performed, for example by measuring the time, the purchase or production of food, filling a vehicle with fuel, or subjected to checking blood pressure.

In commemoration of World Metrology Day the Mexican National Metrology Centre is organizing an Open Day (DPA) during which it will offer guided tours of the facilities CENAM, briefly showing the scientific and technological developments offered by each laboratory measurement.
